Main themes of discussion from the event:				
<p>Main Outcomes</p> <p>Despite the projects we were sharing information on being based in Newhaven it was clear that people don't know about the employability projects and free training for vulnerable people in the area, so it was very positive to share that information. This learning got reinforced by working on the case studies at the tables.</p> <p>This has raised possibility of a course at Sussex Downs as introduction to health and social care to encourage people to think about employment as PAs to help to address the shortage. Potential for increased referrals from volunteering infrastructure to SCDA employability projects.</p> <p>As organisers we felt we need to become more proactive about articulating clear community network recommendations that come from the participants and to find a process for doing so.</p> <p>Gaps</p> <p>The JSNA presentation made clear the level of deprivation particularly in the Havens, this raises significant concerns about the availability of expert benefit advice to this population.</p> <p>Barriers</p> <p>Short term funding for projects, people just get to know about projects and they become established and the funding goes. Communication routes for members between networks, e.g. message board, website etc.</p>
