Main themes of discussion from the event:				
<p>Of the 25 participants attending, 11 completed evaluation forms. While networking was again held to be the most useful aspect of the meeting for participants, there was some indication that participants welcomed the opportunity to feedback on proposals for mental health services for children and young people.</p> <p>Following up on issues raised by both GP practices at Seaford Locality Planning & Delivery Group meetings, this Network meeting focused identifying and highlighting existing services, and in addition participants were asked to comment on proposals for creating more cohesive local services for children and young people's mental health services.</p> <p>There was broad agreement with proposals that included the vision that all practitioners and organisations that support young people in Seaford around mental health and emotional wellbeing work in a co-ordinated way offering and receiving support from each other, sharing skills, knowledge and experience. This will enable there to be a more consistent offer for young people in the town, and reduce the likelihood of duplication or young people who need support getting missed. There will be a baseline expectation of knowledge among these practitioners which will in part be met through the MHFA training.</p>
