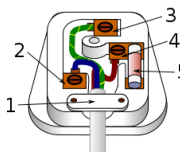

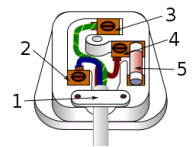

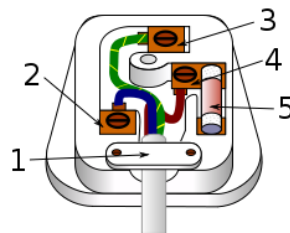

### Did you know that ... ?

**1.** AirS can hire out the equipment to halls for them to undertake their own testing by an individual who has attended this course. Or you could get together with neighbouring Village Halls and purchase the equipment between you.

**2.** PAT testing is **simple** and can **save you money!** You can test your own appliances rather than rely on a contractor. Even if you don't want to carry out your own testing, our course will help you know what your responsibilities are.



**3.** You are required by law to ensure that the electrical equipment you supply in your community building is safe.

**4.** The IET code of practice and fire brigade recommend visual inspection and PAT testing as a means to certify the safety of your appliances.
